## **SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT**

## FOR KEMPER WELFARE BENEFIT PLAN

This is a summary of the annual report of the Kemper Welfare Benefit Plan, EIN 36-1410470, Plan No. 502, health, life insurance, dental, short-term disability, long-term disability, severance, travel accident and accidental death and dismemberment for period January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Lumbermens Mutual Casualty Co. has committed itself to pay all short term disability and severance pay claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

## **Insurance Information**

The plan has contracts with Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, Standard Insurance Company, Life Insurance Company of North America, Blue Cross Blue Shield of Illinois and Pennsylvania Life Insurance Company to pay dental, accidental death, long-term disability, health, prescription drug claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2008 were \$4,187,618.

Because they are so called "experience-rated" contracts, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2008, the premiums paid under such "experience-rated" contracts were \$172,875 and the total of all benefit claims paid under these experience-rated contracts during the plan year was \$(2,229).
